At present, the college is temporarily functioning from LHS Bain Bajalta located in the village panchayat of Bain Bajalta in Dansal block which is in close vicinity of Bajalta railway station. It is located 12 km towards North from district headquarter Jammu. The college is only 04 km from diversion to Bain Bajalta from National Highway. This college is a co-educational institution set amidst spectacular ambience with Shivalik hills on one side and Tawi on the other. The first batch was comprised of 60 students, admitted in Arts and Commerce streams in 2019. In the second batch 149 students were admitted in Arts and Commerce Stream in 2020. Since then, the college has been functioning with flourishing and impeccable growth prospects. ADMISSION PROCESS UNDER CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

ADMISSION RULES

A student who has passed Higher Secondary Part-II Examination (XII Class) of the J&K Board of School Education or an examination recognized as its equivalent by the University of Jammu is eligible for admission to B. A/B.Sc./B. Com/BCA/BBA SEM-I.

Students seeking admission to B. A/B. Com SEM-I shall apply offline only. They should mention their choice of subject combinations in order of their preference as per the combinations available in the college.

Required Documents to be attached with the hard copy of the Admission Form

- ✓ Provisional and Migration certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last attended (Original Only) in case of regular students and from J&K BOSE in case of private students.
- ✓ Three xerox copies of self-attested marks certificate of 10th and 12th class each.
- ✓ Character certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last attended (Original only)
- ✓ **In case of Private candidates, a character certificate signed by a First Class Magistrate /Panchayat Sarpanch /MLA /SHO of the area to which the student belongs to or a Gazetted Officer shall be submitted in original.**
- ✓ Four recent passport size photographs, one to be pasted on the application form.
- ✓ Date of Birth Certificate (two self-attested photocopies)
- ✓ One xerox copy of ration card.
- ✓ Reserved Category certificate from the competent authority as stated in SRO-126/294 (original & two self-attested photocopies thereof)

- ✓ Students passing from school board/University other than J&K Board of School Education/Jammu University are required to produce the migration certificate in original and two self-attested Photocopies thereof.

The decision of the College Principal, in any matter, shall be final and binding.

CHANGE OF SUBJECT/STREAM IS NOT PERMISSIBLE AFTER ADMISSION.

Selection list shall be drawn on the basis of merit i.e., marks obtained in class XII. *Mere mention in the Selection List does not entitle an applicant for admission.*

Student belonging to the reserved categories as listed in SRO 294 dated 25-06-1994 shall get additional weightage of 5% marks (i.e., 30 marks out of total of 600) and these 30 marks shall be added to the total marks secured by the candidate provided he/she submits an attested copy of the valid relevant certificate issued by Competent Authority along with the application form.
