8. e-Affidavit


The main features of the programme are:

All Bachelor's Degree Programme are full-time regular for the specified duration as per National Education Policy (NEP-2020), with Multiple Exit and Entry systems at various stages after even semesters, from the academic session 2022 and onwards.

As per the UGC guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education institutions, candidates who secured a minimum CGPA of 7.5 in a three year Bachelor's Degree Programme shall be allowed to continue studies in the fourth year of the Undergraduate Programme to pursue and complete the Bachelor's Degree with Research/Honours.

Admission in different colleges, affiliated to the University of Jammu, shall be offered for different subjects under different streams, depending upon the subjects being offered in the concerned colleges, as per the eligibility criteria already in vogue.
